Practical lessons will be held in small groups of 3-4 person.

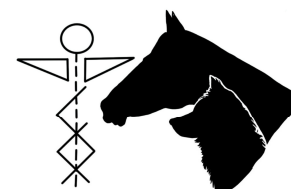
